HIPAA Violations and Penalties:

Under the HIPAA Privacy Rule, falling victim to a healthcare data breach, as well as failing to give patients access to their PHI, could result in penalties:

- **Unknowingly violating HIPAA:** Fined \$100 per violation, with an annual maximum of \$25,000 for repeat violations.
- **Reasonable cause for violating HIPAA:** Fined \$1,000 per violation, with an annual maximum of \$100,000 for repeat violations.
- **Willful neglect of HIPAA,** but the violation is corrected within a given time period, is \$10,000 per violation, with an annual maximum of \$250,000 for repeat violations.

- **Willful neglect of HIPAA**, and the violation remains uncorrected, is \$50,000 per violation, with an annual maximum of \$1.5 million for repeat violations.
